‘Dr Mahathir’s US plan smacks of hypocrisy’

KLUANG — An alleged plan by Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad to head an opposition delegation to the United States in an attempt to topple Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak portrays the hypocrisy of the former leader, said Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Tun Hussein.

He said when Dr Mahathir was the prime minister from 1981 to 2003, he was averse to the Opposition political

parties indulging in such a thing.

“However, it is different now. The people can see his hypocrisy. He does not walk the talk,” the Sembrong MP said to reporters after launching the Sembrong Housing Development Agenda at Sungai 10 Felkra in Paloh yesterday.

Hishammuddin, who is also defence minister and minister with special functions, was commenting on a claim by former DAP vice-chairman Tunku Abdul

Aziz Tunku Ibrahim on Dr Mahathir’s plan.

Tunku Abdul Aziz said on Friday that Dr Mahathir, who is chairman of Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia (Bersatu), planned to visit the US on Feb 20 to garner support for his attempt to topple the present administration.

It was reported that Bersatu president Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin will be part of the delegation. — Bernama
