Questions arise after girl, 14, dies in freak mishap

Nor Afini Roslan was a keen archer who had represented Pahang in the sport. The Form Two student, who was on her school field in Gemas, Negri Sembilan, preparing for Sports Day, died in a freak accident when a lawnmower blade broke off and struck her. The tragedy has raised questions about safety and whether procedure was followed. And it has left a little boy missing his big sister terribly, wondering who will help him with his homework and pamper him now.
