Developer fined by several authorities in joint operation

NINE compounds and notices were issued to a developer during a joint operation, Operasi Tapak, at a construction site in Kuala Lumpur.

The operation involved Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL), Environment and Health Department, Occupational Safety and Health Department (DOSH), Fire and Rescue Department, Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) and Civil Defence Force.

Leading the team was DBKL Enforcement Department senior deputy director Osman Ismail.

"DBKL issued a notice to demolish the wooden walls on site that were put up as illegal housing for workers," Osman said.

The Fire and Rescue Department issued four notices to the developer for failing to comply with fire safety requirements while DOSH and CIDB issued one notice each.

The remaining compounds included one for an unkempt site.

Osman said this was the second joint operation since January and there would be about eight more by year end.

"We want to ensure developers adhere to the approval plan, foreign workers have work permits and the construction site is clean and secure," he said.
