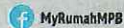

THE New Straits Times Press (NSTP) MyRumah Property Showcase returns to Komtar JBCC here this weekend.

The three-day event beginning yesterday features eight property developers and five non-develop-

ers offering more than 3,400 units of residential and commercial properties with a gross development value of more than RM2.2 billion.

The Johor leg of the showcase is the third in a series of five this

year. MyRumah was held in Kuala Lumpur in March and Melaka last month.

The showcase, now in its third year, is supported by the Housing and Local Government Ministry.

Johor Housing, Communica-

tions and Multimedia Committee chairman Dzulkefly Ahmad, who launched the showcase, said it would help the state government to boost sales of properties in the state.

"Based on positive market sen-

timents, I am confident about the domestic housing and property sector's potential," he said, adding that there were big projects in Johor, which would have spillover effects on the property sector.
