'Rumah Makmur, PR1MA homes not for business'

KUANTAN: Owners of Rumah Makmur and Malaysia People's Housing Programme (PR1MA) in Pahang will have their ownership statuses revoked if they are found to have illegally rented out their houses to third parties. Pahang Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Wan Rosdy Wan Ismail said this also applied to those who turned these units into homestays. He said the programmes were meant to foster home-ownership among the low-income group, not for business. "If we receive such reports, the state government has the authority to claim the houses back from the owners. The state housing unit will monitor to ensure such incidents do not occur," he said after launching the Kampung Tiram Rumah Makmur project here yesterday.
